The college was accredited and awarded Grade "B" by NAAC on February 28, 2005 and subsequently the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) established on 24.05.2005. Since then, it has submitted 10 (ten) Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQARs) namely a) AQAR 2005 - 06 submitted on 16/08/2006, b) AQAR 2006 - 07 submitted on 31/07/2007, c) AQAR 2007 - 08 submitted on 27/03/2009, d) AQAR 2008 - 09 submitted on 03 /10/2012, e) AQAR 2009 - 10 submitted on 03 /10/2012, f) AQAR 2010 - 11 submitted on 03 /10/2012 g) AQAR 2011 - 12 submitted on 03 /10/2012, h) AQAR 2012 - 13 submitted on 03 /10/2012, i) AQAR 2013 - 14 submitted on 03 /10/2012, AQAR 2014 - 15 submitted on 06 /10/2015 and AQAR 2015-16 and submitted on 06 /10/2015.

The NAAC Peer Team visited the college on 15-17 October, 2015 for Re-accreditation (Cycle 2) and accredited with CGPA of 2.62 on 15/11/2015 as B Grade. The result is displayed in the table below:

The IQAC has taken active initiative in publishing 2 (two) ISSN Journals. Faculty members have been encouraged to attend/present research papers in seminars/conferences. Three faculty members have received minor research projects from UGC. Major grievances of students redressed are a) Lack of adequate classrooms, b) Lack of proper cycle stand and c) Disruption of classes due to frequent and unnecessarily lengthy meetings. Two Best Practices of the institution are Log Book System: Introduction of Log Book entry system by faculty members has enhanced regularity & punctuality in curricular transaction (teaching, learning and evaluation) and Student Adalat: The first Saturday of every month is earmarked for Student Adalat to redress their grievances if any.

1. Strength: Centrally located, dedicated faculty and State-of-the-art virtual classroom.
2. Weakness: Lack of communication skill of students in English.
3. Opportunity: Introduction of Commerce stream.
