22. Activities of Student Counseling and Guidance Cell

(a) One day Career counselling session was organized by Career Counselling Cell, Silapathar College in collaboration with 42 Student Group on 3rd April, 2023 for B.A./B.Sc. 6th Semester and H.S. Final Exam Appearing Students to make them aware about various opportunities and recent trends in the various fields after graduation and 12th pass. The resource persons for the programme were Mr. Animesh Singh, Area Manager, 42 Student Group and Mr. Debasish Borah, Regional Manager, 42 Student Group. Mr. Animesh Singh delivered his speech on the various scopes after 12th pass for both science and arts stream students. Mr. Debasish Borah gave lecture about the various career opportunities such as MBA, Hotel Management, MCA, various professional courses. The students cleared their doubts by asking questions regarding scholarship, study loan etc. It was a very informative day for the students. Around eighty students were present in the programme.

(b) One day career guidance programme was organized by Takshashila School of Civil Services in collaboration with Career Counselling Cell, Silapathar College on 27th April, 2023 at Virtual Classroom, Silapathar College. The programme was organized for B.A./B.Sc. Students to make them aware about the career opportunities after completion of graduation. Dr. L.N. Pegu, Principal, Silapathar College, gave a brief introduction about the resource persons. The resource persons for the sessions were Dr. H.S. Sindhu, Academic Head, Takshashila School of Civil Services and Mr. Biju Pegu, Director, Takshashila School of Civil Services. Dr. H.S. Sindhu delivered his speech and gave a brief introduction about civil services examinations conducted by UPSC and APSC. He also discussed about how to prepare for various civil service examinations. Another resource person Mr. Biju Pegu delivered his lecture about the various job opportunities after graduation. He also discussed briefly about the syllabus of civil service examination. After the sessions, the students interacted with the resource persons and asked various career related questions. All the students were highly motivated and benefitted by the sessions. Around 95 no.s of students were participated in the programme.

(c) One day awareness programme on Financial Literacy was organized by Career Counselling Cell in collaboration with SV Wealth Partners for the teaching staff and students of Silapathar College on 9th September, 2023. The resource person Mr. Bimal Jha addressed various issues relating to financial literacy including securities market, Investor-protection fund (IPF), primary and secondary markets, PFO etc. Total number of participants were near about 70. The programme was extended for a time of 45 minutes and ended around 10:15 am. The resource person enlightened the participants to a great extent by his informative lecture.

(d) The Career Counselling Cell of Silapathar College provided the platform to CSC Academy to train our students on Spoken Skill and Job Skills under Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India on 21st September, 2023. The Speaker of the training programme, Mr. Sanjoy Bhuyan who is the Training Co-ordinator of the respective agency illuminated the minds of the students with training skills on Spoken English, Entrepreneurship, Retail-sales, Power-pack, financial literacy, and Digital literacy. At the end of the programme, few registration forms of a Three- Months Certification Course were also distributed among the interested students to enable them to become efficient and competitive in the present world of work. Almost about fifty students actively participated in the programme.

(e) One day Career Counselling and Motivation Session was organized by Career Counselling Cell, Silapathar College in collaboration with Careerclass on 3rd November, 2023. The session was taken up by Mrs. Punam Gogoi, ACS Rank-10 Of 2019 batch and Founder of Careerclass. Knowledge of various career opportunities after doing under graduation was provided. Mrs. Gogoi briefly discussed about the strategies for clearing civil services examinations. Students were motivated to prepare and participate in these career options. There were 100 participants in the session. At last their queries related to various career opportunities were answered.

(f) Career counseling and interactive session was organized by the Career Counselling Cell for the H.S Students (Science Stream) of Silapathar College on 20th November, 2023 in collaboration with Ashreya Academy. The main objective

of the programme was to motivate and guide the students to crack NEET and IIT/JEE entrance exams so that they can bag entry into the best engineering and medical colleges of the country. The number of participants was about ___ in number. The session continued for about 2 hours from 10:00am to 12:00 noon. The Speaker, Mrs Kashtory Baruah delivered insights on specialized study materials, personalized doubt solving methods, exam strategies and time management skills. The session ended with question and answer round from which our students were much benefited.
