Almost 50+ students participated in the programme successfully and got certificates.

b) A Workshop on Deceased Organ Donation was organized by Zuble Foundation in collaboration with Career Counselling Cell and Students Union, Silapathar College on 27/03/2024 at Virtual Classroom, Silapathar College. This workshop is a part of Project VARDAN, in association with North Eastern Development Finance Corporation (NEDFi). The Zuble Foundation is the first and the only Non-Governmental Organization in the entire North- East Region of India working to raise mass awareness and encourage people to support Deceased Organ Donation. It was founded in the year 2013. The Foundation is based at Guwahati, Assam. Priyanka Borah, CEO of Zuble Foundation delivered a talk about the organization and the vision is to dedicate itself to the advancement and/or dissemination of information regarding organ donation and its importance to the society at large; with a vision to meet the shortage crisis of organs in the near future. She motivated and created awareness among the students that receiving an organ can become a life-changing event for people who are suffering from end stage organ failures. Around 83 students were present in the program.

c) An online scholarship test was organised by Bhadra IAS Academy for 6th Semester (B.A and B.Sc) students in collaboration with Career Counselling Cell of Silapathar College on 10th April, 2024. The scholarships can be availed for APSC/UPSC coaching under the Academy. Around 60 students registered for the test and 16 students actually appeared the test on the date. The students were truly inspired and motivated towards preparing for competitive exams after their graduation.
